York County Council Budget Workshop
May 22, 2019

The York County Council met on the above date for a York County Council Workshop at 6:00pm located at 1070 Heckle Boulevard, Rock Hill, South Carolina. The following Council members were present: Council member Joel Hamilton, Council member Allison Love, Vice-Chairwoman Christi Cox, Council member Robert Winkler, Council member Britt Blackwell and Chairman, Michael Johnson. Also present were County Manager, Bill Shanahan, Assistant County Manager, David Harmon, Assistant County Manager, Andy Merriman, Assistant County Manager/Finance Director, Kevin Madden, County Attorney Michael Kendree and Clerk to Council, Karen Brogdon.

Chairman, Michael Johnson called the workshop to order.

1. Assistant County Manager, Andy Merriman presented an update to the fire budget requests.
 - a. Staff is recommending a .6 mil increase for the rural fire district to fund a York County Firefighter Program for shift work, which would be allocated between all 16 departments, based on call volume.
 - b. This will have no impact to this year's budget.
 - c. York County Fire Chief's will meet to discuss the logistics of this program and determine what would work best for the County.
2. Assistant County Manager/CFO/Treasurer, Kevin Madden provided an update on the overall 2019/2020 budget.
 - a. State passed an increase in the LGF (Local Government Fund) which will cover the shortfall in York County Forever funds.

Motion was made by Council member Joel Hamilton and seconded by Council member Allison Love to go into Executive Session to discuss a contractual matter.

There being no matters for consideration following Executive Session, the meeting was adjourned.
