Council to hold a Public Hearing of an ordinance entitled AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH OPERATING AND CAPITAL BUDGETS FOR THE OPERATION OF THE COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF YORK COUNTY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 2019; TO PROVIDE FOR THE LEVY OF TAXES FOR YORK COUNTY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 2019; TO PROVIDE FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF TAX REVENUES AND OTHER COUNTY FUNDS; AND PROVIDE FOR OTHER FISCAL MATTERS RELATING TO COUNTY GOVERNMENT.

(6:03pm) Billy Dunlap, Executive Director of the Rock Hill/York County Convention & Visitor's Bureau presented the 2018-2019 year in review for the CVB and the 2019-2020 proposed budget of \$1,581,722. Mr. Dunlap proposed the following funding for the RH/YC CVB for FY20 and FY21 from York County:

FY 2020: HTax - \$600,000 - 21%
 ATax - \$372,000 - 60%
 Total - \$972,000

FY 2021: HTax - \$300,000 - 10%
 ATax - \$467,543 - 75%
 Total - \$767,543
